IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR THE FESTIVE SEASON

Festive Season - Electrical Safety

To prevent accidents and unnecessary costs, please ensure:

- All electrical appliances are switched off before leaving your unit for the holiday period.
- Unplug non-essential devices (kettles, toasters, heaters, chargers).
- · Check stove plates and ovens are off.
- · Switch off geysers if you will be away for an extended period.

Water Leak Test - Steps to Follow

To avoid unexpected water bills and damage, please conduct a simple leak test:

- 1. Ensure all taps and appliances are turned off.
- 2. Check your water meter reading.
- 3. Wait 30-60 minutes without using water.
- 4. Recheck the meter if the reading has changed, you may have a leak.
- Report any suspected leaks immediately to the trustees or managing agent.

Levy Statements & Office Closure

- Levy statements will be released on Wednesday, 17 December 2025.
- Please ensure payments are made timeously to avoid arrears and that funds are available to pay the BC accounts and avoid disconnections of service by Council.
- No processing will take place during the closure period.

Security Measures

For your safety and the safety of the complex:

- Always wait for the gate to close fully before driving off.
- Do not allow tailgating unknown vehicles must enter separately.
- Ensure visitors are properly signed in and directed.
- · When away on holiday:
